

Pennsylvania FCCLA Dress Code

FCCLA member dress should reflect professional business attire while attending all FCCLA meetings including Regional Leadership Meeting and State Leadership Conference. Star Events and semi-formal events are exceptions and should follow the specific rules listed below. FCCLA members must adhere to National Dress Code Rules while attending nationally sponsored meetings.



Mandatory attire for: General Sessions, Business Sessions, Exhibits, Workshops, STAR Events Recognition Sessions:

Females

- Dress shirts or blouses or dresses, Polo shirts
- Dress slacks/pants/Capris (no shorts)
- Skirts – no shorter than 2 inches above the knee
- Jeans, t-shirts, athletic wear, flip-flop footwear, lounge or sleepwear are not acceptable
- Clothing that are tight, frayed or have holes are not acceptable.
- See-through blouses and shirts, and spaghetti straps/strapless tops are not acceptable.
- Midriff or Low cut shirts or blouses, and tops that exposes under garments are not acceptable.

Males:

- Dress shirt (long or short sleeves), Polo shirts
- Dress slacks (no shorts)
- Jeans, t-shirts, athletic wear, lounge or sleepwear are not acceptable
- Clothing that are tight, frayed or have holes are not acceptable.

Exceptions:

- Culinary Arts participants are welcome to wear their chef's attire during the STAR Events Recognition Sessions.
- STAR Events participants and skilled demonstration participant: Follow event specifications for dress, and wear appropriate clothing for the nature of the presentation
- Gala / Banquet - Females and Males
 - Semi-formal: Females skirts no shorter than 2 inches above the knee, no revealing cuts
 - Jeans, t-shirts, athletic wear, lounge or sleepwear and athletic shoes are not acceptable
- Athletic events – t-shirts, athletic wear and athletic shoes are acceptable

Advisers/ Chaperones/ Guests

- Business casual (including dressy Capris)
- Jeans, t-shirts, athletic wear, lounge or sleepwear are not acceptable
